



## Certificate: Baby Care Practitioner Course - Structure and Delivery Framework

### Specific Outcomes:

At the completion of this qualification, learners will be able, in either a centre-based or non-centre-based setting, to

- Demonstrate a nurturing, patient approach to infant care, embracing the principles of responsive caregiving, promoting secure relationships with children and parents, and emotional safety.
- Maintain and promote the well-being, health, nutrition, safety and protection of infants and toddlers.
- Facilitate and mediate all aspects of the daily routine and programme in a centre-based or non-centre-based setting.
- Plan and prepare stimulating activities that meet the holistic needs of infants and toddlers in centre-based or non-centre-based settings.
- Observe, assess and record each child's progress.

### The Certificate: Baby Care Practitioner consists of:

- Knowledge modules,
- Practical Tasks and
- Workplace Experience Tasks and Observations

These modules will be internally assessed by the Training Provider in preparation for the Final Integrated Summative Assessment (FISA) which will be managed by the Training Provider, Colbe College.

#### *Knowledge modules*

Learners will be required to complete the following 5 Knowledge Modules.

- KM-01 - Baby Caregiver Profile
- KM02: Essential Care
- KM03: Health and safety
- KM04: Stimulation of Infants and Toddlers in a child-care setting
- KM05: Classroom Management

### *Practical Skills Modules*

Learners will practice knowledge and skills in group activities, role playing and discussions aligned to the Knowledge Modules in the training centre.

### *Workplace Component*

In addition to the Knowledge and Practical Skills Modules, Learners will observe caregivers in the workplace and apply knowledge and skills acquired in the previous modules to perform various tasks in the workplace.

### **Final Summative Integrated Assessment**

Learners will be assessed for competence according to the specific outcomes of the course, the workplace, as they carry out the tasks designed to determine the learner's competence.

### **Programme Delivery Framework**

Knowledge, Practical and Workplace components will run concurrently, with learners exposed to the workplace environment daily. This course will also include a Foundational Language Module and a Trauma Response Module.
